CLASSES XI & XII

Attendance Requirement:

- All students are required to complete 75% of attendance to be eligible to take the examination.

Core and Elective Subjects Offered:

- English, Math, Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Computer Science, Economics, Business Studies, Accountancy, Physical Education, Psychology, Hindi, History, Commercial Arts, Political Science.

Rules for Change of Subject:

- Change of subject (s) in class XI may be allowed by the Head of the School but not later than 15 July of that academic session.
- No candidate shall be permitted to change his subject of study after passing Class XI.
- The candidate shall not be offered that subject in Class XII which he has not studied and passed in Class XI.
